



Redefine Your Reality

syio! (Greetings) “*Beloved I wish above all things that you prosper and be in health even as your soul prospers.*” **3 John 2.** Our prayer for you is the same as the Apostle John wrote in this verse. Notice that he wishes above *all things* that you have health in your body, health in your soul, and prosperity in your secular affairs. These three things are so necessary to the comforts of life. Every observant believer has the right to expect each of these blessings.

Are you suffering from sickness, afflictions, relationship or financial problems? Do you feel cursed at times? Here is some good news: observe that Jesus has redeemed us from these curses! **Galatians 3:13-14** says “*Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.*” (emphasis mine)

Yes, prosperity is a blessing of Abraham as described in **Deut 28:1-14**. **Psalms 35:27** also says that the Lord gets pleasure from the prosperity of his servant and likewise, does not get pleasure from our adversity! Praise the Lord!

The Christian walk is one that requires a daily renewing of the mind. To “redefine reality” is *having an open mind with a view to change*. Allow the Holy Spirit to teach you these truths (John 16:13). Jesus told us in **Matthew 6:33** “*But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*” The Greek word for “seek” here means to research, meditate and strive after. When we research, meditate and strive after the things of God, then all “things” will be added to us.

The world’s definition of prosperity is financial power, political power, social favor and military power and greed. However, the Christian believer should have a different definition of this word.

We must redefine “prosperity” as “the ability to use God’s ability and power to meet the needs of mankind—regardless of what those needs may be.”

The blessings that Jesus died for reveals that God is a good God (Romans 2:4) and wants His children to be blessed, not unlike the way we want our children to be healthy, happy and successful in life!

Let us encourage you to **redefine your reality** by meditating on the blessings of Abraham as described in **Deuteronomy 28:1-14**. We pray that all of our partners and friends may have success in the works of their hands and their plans of life.

Jesus loves you and so do we!

The Holy Spirit will lead you to where God wants you to be planted **IF** you will trust that still, small voice. Most believers go to a church because it is the one that their family or friends attend. Don’t be surprised if your friends are not as committed to God as you are and don’t let their doubt alter your faith.

Your destiny is directly connected to the church you are attending.

Allow the Holy Spirit to lead you to your “home” church and you **“shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.”** Psalms 1:3. There is that word “prosper” again. God wants you to prosper so that you can help others!
