



Redefine Your Reality

Esyio to all of our readers on and off the Rez! We pray blessings upon you as your walk of faith grows each day!

Over five years ago Creator revealed to me that one of my missions was to help His children “**Redefine Reality**” through the written word as well as preaching. To “**redefine reality**” means we must have an open mind with a **view to change**. As a born again believer in Jesus (Yeshua) you have someone that will help you do this - He is the Holy Spirit (John 14:26).

Do you need a breakthrough in the problem areas of your life? Does your prayer life seem stagnate? Romans 12:2 in the NLT tells us “*Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will know what God wants you to do, and you will know how good and pleasing and perfect his will really is.*” If you will begin reading the Word of God with an open mind and an attitude of change then your reality, your world, will be changed forever!

Are you focusing on your problem more than you are focusing on your Covenant Promises? It will take an extra effort but you will see positive results if you stay focused on the blessings that Jesus paid for. It is like riding a motorcycle. Bikers know that the bike will go where their eyes are focused. If they focus on a pothole then the bike will hit that pothole every time. However, if they focus on the road around the hole, the bike will safely pass by the pothole.

Let us encourage you to take time to “be still” and know that the Holy Spirit is there to teach you what you need in order to receive a breakthrough in your life. The Message translation of Psalms 46:10 has a sweet way of stating this: “*Step out of the traffic! Take a long, loving look at Me, your High God, above politics, above everything!*” Friends, if you **take a long, loving look at God, He will take a long loving look at you!** (Emphasis mine)

Jesus loves you and wants to develop a relationship with you. Psalms 103:1-5 is worthy of our attention. Verse two tells us, “Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits.” There are countless benefits when we become believers. One of them says He heals all of our diseases. Healing is a bought and paid for gift. The more we focus on the love that God has for us the more we will be able to “redefine” our reality and receive these gifts. If you want your kids to be happy and in good health, how much more would our heavenly Father want His kids to be happy and in good health?

Practice spending a little *extra* time each day reading your Bible. Ask and the Holy Spirit will show you how to redefine your reality all the way to a victorious life!

Divine Healing

Have you heard reports of people being healed by prayer or in a church service only to have the symptoms come back on them a few days/weeks later? This has been one of the tactics that the devil uses to convince us that divine healing is not for today.

Healing is a bought and paid for gift for everyone! The gift of healing is not only to heal you but also to keep you healed! However, many folks do not realize that there is more to do after they received healing. Part of *redefining our reality* is that we must make a serious effort to change the way we think (Romans 12:2) as sometimes the symptoms will try to come back on you. The devil will always try to re-establish his infliction by stealing the truth of the Word from us. He does it by getting us to speak words of unbelief.

God is **not** the author of sickness. The devil inflicts us with sickness and doesn't like it when God's Word brings healing and destroys his work. Jesus gave not only promises and commands, but warnings as well.

Stay in an atmosphere of Faith

To stay healed you should be in a church where the leadership believes and teaches it is God's will to heal everyone. That just might not be the church you are currently attending. God gives us a warning concerning some churches in **2 Timothy 3:5**, *Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof; from such turn away.* Will you still go to heaven if you stay in a church like this? Of course you will--you may just get there a whole lot quicker than God originally intended. There are many good churches where the full gospel is preached and the power of God is recognized and works for healing of the sick. Identify yourself with one of these groups. There you will find food for your faith and you can freely give your testimony for the encouragement of others who may also need healing or deliverance.

From Jesus

Sin and careless living on the part of one who has been healed is an open door for an unclean spirit to move back into their life. Jesus warned one whom He had healed instantly and miraculously with these words: *Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee* (John 5:14).

Do not give place to sickness

Ephesians 4:27 says "Leave no such room or foothold for the devil (give no opportunity to him)"

You have the power to refuse to give sickness a foothold. There is something better than being healed "many times" and that is to get healed and **stay** healed. It is called walking in Divine Health.

We walk in Divine Health by faith. Faith is joyful; a sick person who lacks faith is sorrowful because of his pain and sickness. The sick person who has faith is joyful because he realizes that victory is his and confesses it has happened! He will rejoice and praise God from his heart, regardless of what he sees or feels.

This kind of faith cannot fail to bring healing. Satan knows that faith is your powerful weapon and constantly strives to destroy it. Whenever you feel any pain which remotely resembles the pain of your previous problem, Satan will immediately suggest to your mind that you were never healed or that your healing didn't last.

Death and Life is in the power of the Tongue!

Proverbs 18:21

All throughout the Bible we are told about the power of our words. There is healing in the words you speak! Proverbs 15:4 Amplified version says, "A gentle tongue (with its healing power) is a tree of life, but willful contrariness in it breaks down the spirit." Note that contrariness breaks down the spirit. "Contrariness" here means speaking words that are contrary to the Word of God or contrary to what you know as truth.

Do not be surprised if you feel a symptom trying to come back on you. This is the devil's way of trying to get you to say something contrary to the truth. You may even be thinking things like, "Oh, I guess I wasn't healed after all". **Do Not Say** words like this! Instead, speak to the symptom (like pain): "In the name of Jesus I rebuke you, pain" and remind your body that "by the stripes of Jesus I was healed!" (1 Peter 2:24). Then praise Him for your healing!
