



Redefine Your Reality

Osyio (Greetings) and blessings on a most prosperous New Year to all of our partners and friends! I am pleased to report that we are still seeing a tremendous move of God on our First Nations (Native American) reservations! We are seeing an “awakening” among native people that never before knew God or Jesus! “Who is this Jesus that keeps showing up in our meetings?” they are asking the native pastors, “we want to know more about your God!” For an evangelist, this is like going fishing and having the fish jump in your boat!

A revival, by definition, is “renewed attention to or interest in something old” or Christian “believers” fired up about God “again” with converts in the process. However, this “Awakening” on our reservations is a supernatural divine awareness! Natives who rejected God before are having visitations, visions and dreams of a Loving Creator God! Today’s Awakening to God cannot be tied to any one church group. It is the Holy Spirit of God Himself preparing these wonderful people to take their place in the body of Christ! (John 16:8-11)

Romans 13:11 says “*And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to **awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed.***” KJV (emphasis mine). We are to awake out of the sleep of carnality and spiritual negligence and even to awake out of spiritual deadness.

Recently in prayer groups, the Lord has revealed that we need to “*pray the other side.*” Isaiah 58:12 talks about building a bridge. A bridge must have two lanes of traffic, one for each direction to be effective. For over 400 years we have seen Christian missionaries go into the Native Reservations (one side of the bridge) but we have seen very little to none of Native preachers coming out preaching to us (the other side).

If a child is born without a big toe on his right foot, he would think he is normal until he sees other people *with* a big toe on their right foot. He could run but not to the best of a normal person’s ability. The Body of Christ in America is like this child--missing a very important part--the First Nations voice! We are missing their anointing and the Word that God has reserved just for them to share to the world! These precious people have been “preserved” on the “reserve” for this great end time move of God!

Are we ready to receive our missing part? They will have a very different message, but it will be ALL God! New revelations of God’s Word, new music, and new dances to set the captives free! Now is the time! It is high time to awaken unto God! Jesus is coming soon and he is coming for a glorious church without spot or wrinkle and all parts in place! Let us embrace our First Nations leaders and welcome them into our meetings outside of their reservations. You will be blessed beyond measure! Aho!

What is more “real” to you, God or man?

Jesus says in **Luke 18:17** that “*Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it.*” This scripture so reminds me of my early walk on the Jesus Path. I was not raised in a church at all as a child and in many ways that has been a blessing. At least I wasn’t raised in a church that taught the wrong things about God! On August 12th, 1988, I experienced an “I-35 Road to Damascus”. During an after-death divine encounter with Creator, I made Jesus Lord over my life. I was supernaturally healed of all wounds, both physically and emotionally as I read the Bible for the first time in my life! I wasn’t told any different so I believed what the Bible said in **1 Peter 2:24** – that by His stripes I was healed!

Reading the Bible for the first time at age 31, I felt so “behind” other believers in my new church that I decided to totally immerse myself in the Word to “catch up” with Christians my age and do what the above scripture said to do. I felt like a little child reading the Bible for the first time. When I read that we are supposed to go into the world and heal the sick, raise the dead and cast out demons, I remember saying “okay, Lord.” Jesus never said “no” to anyone that asked for healing so there was never a doubt that it was God’s will to heal everyone! **John 10:10** seemed clear that it was the “thief” that came to kill, steal and destroy – not Jesus! Who is the thief? At first I assumed it was the devil and there is nothing wrong with thinking that because he is the father of all lies. However, recently I have done some deeper research and found that the Greek word “Kleptes” used in this verse for ‘thief’ actually means “false teaching for one’s personal gain.” So it is false teaching that says that God is responsible for death and destruction! My friends, do not believe this lie! God is not responsible for the bad decisions or the ignorance of His children!

God’s Word says there are benefits for choosing the Jesus Path. Meditate on Psalms 103 for the next few weeks and let the Holy Spirit reveal these truths to you. Here are just a few of the many covenant benefits from Psalms 103 that Jesus paid for with his blood (Gal 3:13-14): 1) He forgives all your sins, 2) He heals all your diseases, 3) He redeems your life from destruction, 4) He crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies, 5) He satisfies your mouth with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s, 6) He executes righteousness and judgment for you against oppression and He sets you free, 7) He makes known His ways to you and 8) He gives you His grace and mercy in times of need.

Do you have an open mind so you can redefine your reality? Will you make God’s Word more “real” to you than what the world has taught you? Ask the Holy Spirit to show you how to read the Bible again as a little child and just say, “okay Daddy!”

Is it that simple? Only if you believe!

I ask that you please pray for me as well as I take this new position this month for my tribe. I was asked to fill a vacancy when another Chief had to move outside our district. We want prosperity for our people not for greed, but to help others. That is the Native Way – our motivation for accumulating wealth is to distribute to those in need.



Scholarships for the youth, classes to preserve our language, history and culture, feeding the poor, we were born to give back to the earth and all life it holds. Interesting point here – this is the Jesus Way, too! Read Matthew 25:34-36.
